EXAMINATION RULES AND PROCEDURE

- 1. The following stationary must be brought to school for the relevant examinations:
- 1.1 at least two good blue or black pens
- 1.2 stapler, ruler, pencil and eraser
- 1.3 Mathematics set where necessary
- 2. Tippex may not be used. A neat line must be drawn through mistakes.
- 3. Pocket calculators may be used.
- 4. No person may leave the examination room during the exam.
- 5. Before the examinations commence ALL books, notes and other material must be placed in front of the exam room.
- 6. There must be absolute silence during the exam and NO COMMUNICATION may take place.
- 7. If learners need extra paper the invigilator must be asked.
- 8. The invigilator may not be asked any questions to explain the exam paper.
- 9. No borrowing may take place during the exam.
- 10. No hot water bottles, good luck charms, pencil cases or toys will be allowed on the desks. These items will be confiscated.
- 11. NO CELLPHONES, SMART WATCHES OR MP3 PLAYERS WILL BE ALLOWED under any circumstances. If found in possession of any of these items, zero will be given for such an exam.
- 12. Learners who arrive late for the exam will not be allowed to write.
- 13. The examination will be until 13:00 every day NO LEARNER MAY LEAVE BEFORE THIS TIME.
- 14. The exam will start at 08:00 every day. All learners to be in the exam room at 08:00, whether your specific paper starts or not.
- 15. Learners must make sure that they write their names on the answer sheets and number the questions correctly.
- 16. Learners who are absent MUST bring a doctor's certificate or they will not be assessed for the specific paper.
